

Structure Fire in Arapahoe County

Arapahoe County, CO – On Sunday Morning at approximately 1:35 am Cunningham Fire Rescue responded on a structure fire at 20901 E. Hampden Place in Unincorporated Arapahoe County. The fire occurred in a single family home that was occupied at the time of the fire. All occupants were able to escape from the home. One person was transported to an area hospital for smoke inhalation.

When fire suppression crews arrived on scene, they found a large fire on exterior of the rear side of the home. The fire was rapidly extending to the interior and attic areas. The fire was declared under control approximately forty-five minutes after the arrival of the first suppression crews.

Approximately twenty firefighters were on-scene including fire companies from Parker Fire and South Metro Fire/Rescue that also responded to assist with the suppression of the fire. The Arapahoe County Sheriff assisted with controlling and securing the scene.

There were no injuries sustained by the firefighters and the cause of the fire is under investigation. Fire investigators were on-scene early Sunday morning to determine the cause of the fire. At this time Arson has been ruled-out.

Smoke alarms alerted the occupants of the home of the fire. Remember to test your smoke alarms regularly, develop a home escape plan, and practice escape drills.
