

# Structure Fire in Centennial

Centennial, CO – On Monday morning at approximately 3:51am Cunningham Fire Rescue responded to a structure fire at 17187 E. Crestline Avenue in the Smoky Hill subdivision in the City of Centennial.

When fire crews arrived on scene, the rear of the single family residence was fully involved in fire. The fire has also spread to the first and second floors of the interior. The home was occupied at the time by one occupant who resides at the residence. He was able to escape without sustaining any injuries. The rest of his family in on a trip outside of the country and were not home at the time.

Approximately 30 firefighters were on-scene including fire companies from Parker Fire and South Metro Fire/Rescue that also responded to assist with the suppression of the fire. The Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office assisted with controlling and securing the scene. The American Red Cross also responded to provide assistance to the displaced occupant of the home.

There were no injuries sustained by the firefighters. The cause of the fire is under investigation. Investigators have ruled-out arson and confirmed that the fire started on a deck located on the rear of the home; however, a specific cause has not been determined at this time. Initial estimates on damage are \$325,000.
