

Structure Fire in Arapahoe County

Arapahoe County, CO – At approximately 2:15pm today Cunningham Fire Rescue responded to a structure fire at the Greentree Village Apartments located at 1039 S. Parker Road. The initial report was that there was a fire inside of a wall. When the first responding units arrived on scene there was light smoke coming from the apartment where the fire originated. Fire crews were able to quickly make entry and found that a fire had started inside of a wall where maintenance workers were repairing a pipe.

The fire was quickly extinguished; however, there was a concern that the fire had spread inside of the wall. A search for hidden fire required searching for fire spread in walls located in an adjacent apartment by removing drywall and portions of the ceiling. Damage is estimated at \$4000. The apartment where the fire originated was vacant. Only one family from the other apartment was displaced. The displaced family will be relocated to another apartment in the complex until repairs to their unit can be completed.

Cunningham Fire Rescue is a Fire Protection District serving approximately 57,000 citizens by providing fire and Emergency Medical Services to urban portions of central Unincorporated Arapahoe County which includes portions of the City of Centennial. Cunningham Fire provides these services from three fire stations, with 73 uniformed firefighters and an administrative staff of six.
